PROCESS – How to submit an idea to GEON:

- Submit ideas through the GEON online form
 - o Link: GEON Supplier Value Creation Submission Form
 - Fill in all required information and attach any supporting documents to help assess and categorize the project
- Geon will review each submission within 3-4 weeks and
 - Provide feedback if the project will be worked on immediately, tabled for a later date, additional time needed, or not accepted (and reasoning).
 - In some cases, we may require additional information or pre-work from you. We appreciate prompt responses within a week of request to keep this process moving forward.
 - Projects selected will be assigned within GEON to the proper functional lead and we will outline project charter with timing and actions to be agreed on between GEON and supplier.

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
